- **Location:** Champoeg State Park - 8239 Champoeg Rd NE, Saint Paul, OR 97137
- **Starting Time:** The run will start at 10:30am (if you aren't competing for 1st place, it's okay if you start late)
- **Cost to Park:** You'll need a day use parking permit which you can buy for \$5 as you enter the park (or [buy an annual pass](#) online in advance)
- **Where to Park:** Park in the Riverside area lot
- **Where to Meet:** We will be meeting in the covered Pavilion just a short walk from the parking lot
- **What to Bring:** water, comfortable shoes, your favorite festive wear, and a smile – we're going to have some fun!

The Route

We will be going on the paved paths from the Riverside area to just beyond the campground and back. There will be signs and some balloons marking the route and some helpers to steer our younger runners in the tricky spots. Here is an overview of the route.
